Hindsight on Water Cost

Infinite Complex is deeply concerned and invested in our worldwide water situation. Certainly, **Infinite Complex** pays close attention to efforts directed towards the reality of less water and more people.

In California, a billion dollars was spent to build the largest, most technologically advanced and energy-efficient seawater desalination plant in the USA. **Infinite Water Inc.** wondered at the claims, the negative impact and the supposed cost and the amount of water to be generated. Each day, the plant delivers nearly 50 million gallons of fresh, desalinated water to San Diego County – enough to serve approximately 400,000 people and accounting for about one-third of all water generated in the County. The plant took nearly 14 years to permit, design, and build. Upon completion, it became the largest desalination plant in the Western Hemisphere, but at a billion dollars. To add more fiscal punishment the plant will cost San Diego County \$108 million a year.

Infinite Water Inc. realized from the start that those advancing the plant were less informed or just did not face the facts. The knowledge was provided at the start but now the reality is stark- plant discharge has noticeably increased nearby salinity, though touted as a "climate-proof" water source, at times the plant has been temporarily closed due to red tides.

Infinite Water Inc. believes that a more thorough consideration was not favored. For instance, the cost of water from the plant will be \$100 to \$200 more per acre-foot than recycled water. NOW, water reuse is a central focus, as are various recycled water projects, water reuse programs, and advanced water treatment projects.

Infinite Water Inc. and **Infinite Complex** wonders why **ATMOSPHERIC WATER GENERATION** is not a top of the list consideration.
