## The tariff opportunities

**Infinite Water Inc. & Infinite Complex**, being 'glass half full' businesses looks at the action, which is expected to take effect this week, and includes a 25% duty on all imports from Mexico and most goods from Canada (except a 10% carve-out for crude oil), and an additional 10% tariff on Chinese goods imported into the United States.

The US has the 10<sup>th</sup> largest oil reserves in the world. A 10% increase will not affect us more then the up and down prices we already experience. Infinite Water Inc. & Infinite Complex has looked at many photographs from the 1960's and what is noticeable is that 90% of all cars were manufactured in the USA. Today only 34% of cars in the US are actually made here. With technological manufacturing developments, this can be turned around. When it comes to computers and electronics we can see the US highest trade deficit. If there is to be a benefit to the new tariffs it will be in the US bringing back the chip industry to the US.
