Water Bankruptcy

Infinite Water Inc. and Infinite Complex are aware of a new report from the United Nations that warns humanity has entered an era that researchers call “**water bankruptcy.**” In many regions, yearly rainfall and river flows are no longer enough to meet demand. And In response, countries are increasingly drawing down groundwater reserves that can take centuries, or even millennia, to refill. It also finds that roughly 70 percent of major aquifers are now in decline, raising concerns that some losses may be difficult – or even impossible – to reverse.

Infinite Water Inc. and Infinite Complex wonder why there isn’t more media concern or reporting focused on the scale of the problem that is already so visible. There should be much more attention when reports estimate that three out of four people live in countries facing water shortages, contamination, or drought, and about four billion people experiencing water scarcity for at least one month each year. That number represents half the people on earth.

Infinite Water Inc. and Infinite Complex find that the UN report links water stress to wider social instability. It describes water scarcity as a force that can fuel migration, conflict, and unrest. These aren’t “future risks.” They are present-day symptoms of land and water systems being pushed past their limits.

Infinite Water Inc. and Infinite Complex understand the phrase “**water bankruptcy**” as a simple money metaphor that explains the problem like this- worlds checking account of surface waters such as rivers, lakes and seasonal runoff is almost empty. Meanwhile the savings humans inherited, including glaciers and long-term stores are being drained.
