Water is more precious than oil. Period!

Infinite Water and Infinite Complex recognize that the war in the Middle East is exposing the regions extreme vulnerability to water stress. While it's impossible to know where the war in the Middle East is heading among all the claims and fake news, whatever happens the war has exposed the acute vulnerability of the Mid East's water and its infrastructure. So, aside from casualties and keeping score the issue of water is kept silent. In place for a significant issue, oil and gas resources are the main topic of awareness and complaints.

Infinite Water and Infinite Complex has brought this topic to the forefront of the immense need for understanding many times. Water is much more important to the Gulf states survival than all the oil and gas fields, refineries, and export terminals combined. Historically the Gulf region has always lacked water because of its limited groundwater reserves. But once oil production began to bloom, water production quickly outstripped water supply. This has been offset by the creation of over 400 desalination plants throughout the Gulf region.

Infinite Water and Infinite Complex understand that, so far, there has only been a couple of attacks directly targeting the regions desalination plants, (which account for desalinated water to quench thirst for at least 100 million people in the Gulf). **Infinite Water and Infinite Complex** are aware that civilian infrastructure sites like water plants are clearly banned as targets by international law. This week after President Donald Trump, floated on Monday, the possibility of expanding the Iran war by potentially striking water treatment plants in Iran, forced some Gulf countries to reiterate grave concerns to the Trump administration about any strikes on civilian infrastructure and the risk of an intensifying tit-for-tat escalation, according to four regional sources. This shows what is really at stake for the civilian populations in the Gulf area.
