2. **System Architecture & Proprietary Components:** Establish a robust architectural framework for advanced water treatment, integrating custom-designed proprietary components.
3. **Multi-Barrier Treatment Integration:** Develop and incorporate copper/silver ionization as a core component of a multi-barrier purification strategy, supplemented by advanced filtration and complementary treatment methodologies.

Implementation & Future Outlook

IWI and **BAI** will jointly manage the end-to-end development lifecycle—evaluating system feasibility, conducting manufacturability assessments, and adhering to strict regulatory and compliance standards under patent attorney oversight. Special emphasis will be placed on design-for-manufacturing (DFM) and assembly considerations to streamline future manufacturing readiness and transfer activities.

Looking ahead, both organizations anticipate scaling this collaborative model to support **IWI's** ongoing intellectual property development, burgeoning operations in India, and affiliated AI subsidiaries.
